PART 2: Other news

Agreements since last Nordic Meeting	
New agreement with general upper secondary education, social and health care training program and Vocational educations	New conducted surveys in three fields - general upper secondary education, social and health care training program and Vocational educations -meant that new agreements have been made, each resulting in a 9,3% increase of the remuneration

Preparatory youth education

New agreement with the Preparatory youth education, which is a new, merged education area. The new agreement will not influence the overall level of remuneration as it equalized the decline in other educational areas proportionally.

Business Academies

During 2017 and 2018 we conducted a survey of the copying patterns at the Business Academies – the first in this area. The survey demonstrated a much higher consumption than anticipated and these patterns has now resulted in a new agreement with a 60 % price increase.

Agreement regarding public events and concerts

An agreement allowing the use of song texts at public events (not political or commercial). The agreement is limited to Danish rightsholders (rightsholders living in Denmark or Danish rightsholders living abroad). A new ECL approval based on the DCA article 50(2)

Collaboration with the Royal Danish Library (the administrative library)

A trial agreement that allows government institutions with an agreement with Copydan to order non-fiction texts to be delivered digitally. Otherwise, the library delivers the texts by sending the book via postal services. A new ECL approval based on the DCA article 50(2)

Projects since last meeting

Optimization project

Optimization of registration in our database of rightsholders through automatic loading of reports, automatic database searches and data enrichment.

Digital reporting

Survey of new digital reporting possibilities through for instance digital platforms like Google Dive, Dropbox and OneNote as well as educational platforms like Meebook and Lectio

Navision project

Comprehensive IT-project designed to split our IT infrastructure from the rest of the Copydan-associations. At the same time, we have established a new mail domain, @tekstognode.dk

University survey

New survey started in 2018 among all 8 universities in Denmark. Gathering of data was finished in 2022 and then the agreements shall be renegotiated.

Thank you-campaign

Use of ambassadors (writers and composer) in the communication campaign that supports the reporting activities carried out by the primary schools. Production of materials, small films etc.

New website and presence on LinkedIn

Fusion of two prior websites to one united, adapted all target groups. Launch of presence on LinkedIn with weekly posts, news, and campaigns.

LEGISLATION CHANGES

Two step implementation of the DSM-directive

- The first step of the implementation consists of implementing articles 15 and 17 and the SatCab IIDirective.

<p>Modernized compensation scheme on private copying levies -</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The second step of implementing the DSM-directive will take place in 2022 and a proposal is expected to be made public before the summer vacation. <p>The Compensation scheme has been extended to also cover devices in order to ensure compliance with EU law. At present the levy system doesn't cover compensation for text but rightsholders are trying to get text included in the system. An evaluation is due to take place in about two years. Also worth noting that there is a court case in Denmark where the rightsholders have made a claim against the Ministry of Culture for neglecting to adapt the levy system in accordance with EU legislation and EU case law.</p>
